5. Introduction to Tourism and Hospitality in BC Textbook

- Wendy Anderson and Rebecca Wilson-Mah
- Introducing the second edition of the textbook "Introduction to Tourism and Hospitality in BC"
- The second edition has updated content and improved accessibility/interaction features (multiple formats, added hyperlinks, H5P, etc.)
- New resources are becoming available on the BC Campus website: Introduction to Marketing, Consumer Behaviour (Fall), Digital Marketing (Fall), etc.

6. Rejuvenated "Winning Pitch" Competition

- Blair Baldwin, Jonathan Rouse, and Michael Conlin
- Presentation by a team of Okanagan College Students (Darby Svendsen, Myles Mattila, Tyler Love, and Dylan Warwaruk).
- The Winning Pitch competition has been in abeyance for the past two years.
- In consultation with Go2HR and Destination BC, the student group developed a proposal to resurrect the Winning Pitch Competition with a new concept and new name: "The Perfect Pitch Competition"

- Key characteristic of the new concept: two-stage event (part 1 virtual/video; part 2 in-person at the BCTIC), all specialties, Canada-wide, and involvement of all stakeholders (students, educators, and employers).
- Support was expressed to bring "The Winning Pitch" back. Some questions were expressed about creating a cross-institutional course or team for students.

7. High School Tourism Curriculum

- Monique Paassen brought up a concern from the secondary school sector (Burnaby) regarding the low enrolment in tourism classes and low profile of tourism education in general.
- Some ideas to address these concerns include articulation agreements between the secondary and post-secondary sectors, visits to high school classes, career awareness presentations, reaching out to parents, etc.
- We all acknowledge this is a long-standing challenge.

8. BCCAT Update

- Mike Winsemann
- The Pandemic had no negative impact on articulation activities
- Joint Annual Meeting (JAM) online over two-days this year. Experience exceeded expectations with over 350 delegates and a lower cost than in the past. The event will be online again in November 2021
- Research BCCAT Spring Update: https://bccat.ca/pubs/Resources/ACUpdate202104.pdf
- BC Transfer Guide is now Global in scope
- Challenge to maintain and update articulating agreements. New initiatives underway to review articulation agreements at a system level.
- Consultation underway to expand scope of course equivalencies to be more inclusive.
- If we have block transfer agreements, be sure to inform BCCAT so they may enter them in the system.
- Visit the central data warehouse as well as the student transitions project which is run out of the provincial government. This project has tracked student mobility data since 2002.
- BC is ahead of all other provinces on tracking student mobility.

9. Go2HR Update

- Andrea Hink
- The Go2HR team is smaller now
- Strategic direction to create awareness and provide relevant services
- Support employers, students, and job seekers safety plans, HR services, training, and labour market information projects,
- Training projects:
 - i. Developing an online health and safety program for tourism and hospitality funded by the Ministry of Tourism. Pre-registration is now available. Program will launch in May.
 - ii. Seeking to expand training portfolio with partner institutions and inviting input.
