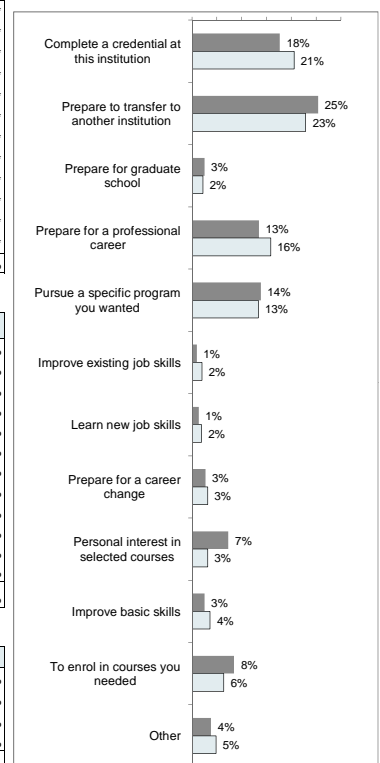

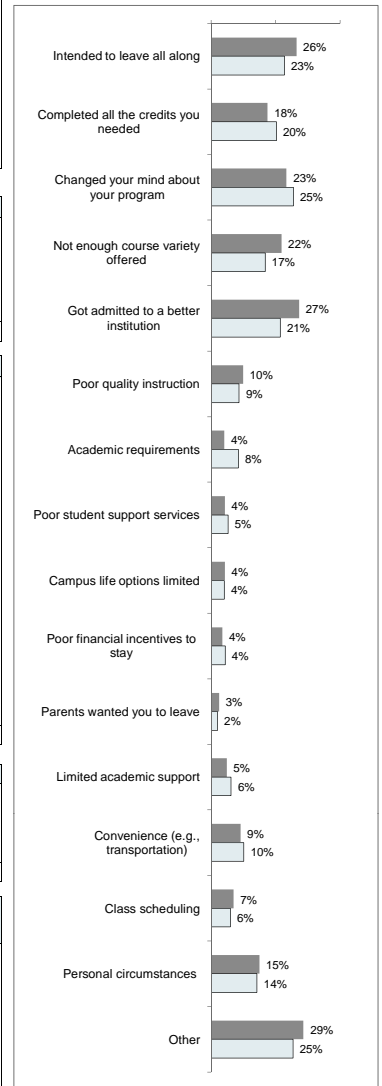

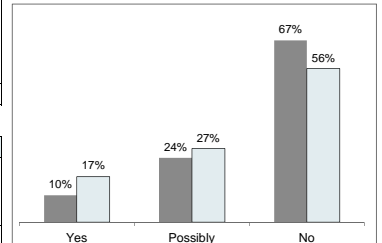

Expect to Return to Inst in Future

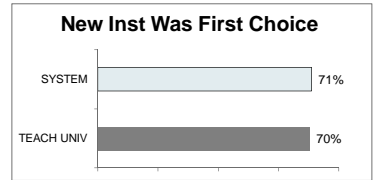

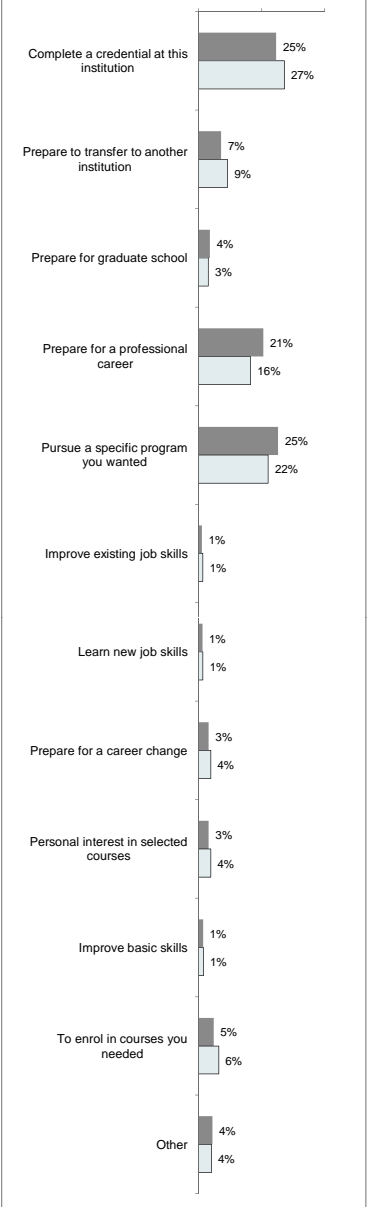

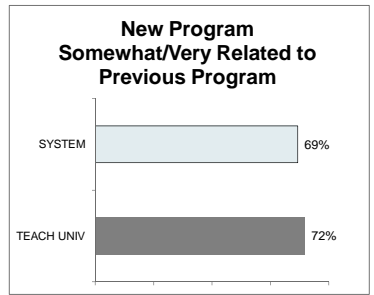

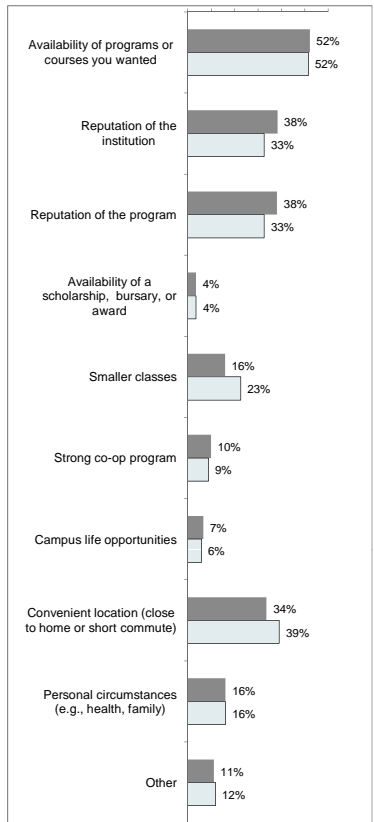

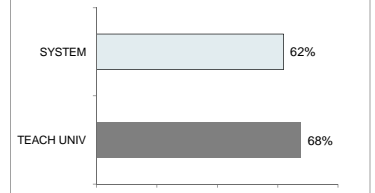

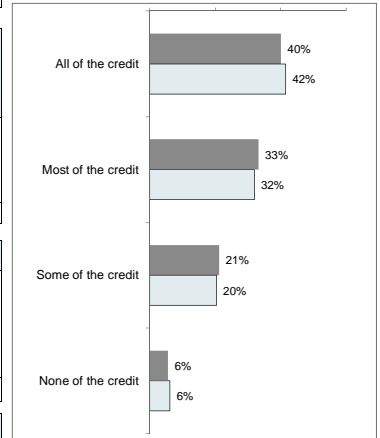
